

2010 Initiatives Realized Boldly in 2011

In 2011, Alternatives purchased, retrofitted and now operates a 36-foot recreational vehicle (RV) for use as our Mobile Testing

Clinic. Operated by our staff Registered Nurse, volunteer Client Advocates and drivers, the Mobile serves communities in Castle Rock, Englewood, Montbello, Golden and Parker with pregnancy tests, counseling and ultrasounds. And, STD testing and treatment will be available in June of 2012.

The Diamond Standard, our 10-lesson curriculum, was presented in 16 area schools to 2,693 students in 2010. Last year, in 2011, that number was increased to 4,166 students. Additionally, 18 new curriculum educators were trained equipping 8 new community organizations with the curriculum to offer their student population. This now positions the curriculum for continued statewide impact and expanded use including churches, youth services

centers, women's crisis and family outreach centers, area health education centers, high schools, the Department of Human Services and victim assistance programs.

Alternatives Pregnancy Center exists to care for Denver-area women and men in pregnancy-related crisis and offer them a meaningful alternative to abortion. Following the example of Christian love, we seek to meet emotional, physical and spiritual needs, enabling and encouraging women and men to choose life every day.

We provide a 24-Hour Helpline, pregnancy tests, ultrasound services, confidential consultation, STD testing and treatment, adoption education, pre- and post-natal medical care referrals, financial and legal assistance, post-abortion counseling, success development curriculum and abstinence education. All services are provided free of charge.



Women Served

Over 7,600 women and their families reached out to Alternatives in 2011. Staff and volunteers initiated and received 6,400 client contacts. Teens and women seeking information and counseling made over 2,700 visits to our offices.

Lifestyle and Success Development Presentations

31% of our clients had negative pregnancy tests. We had the opportunity to help these women re-evaluate their sexual choices. Our success development program, A Promising Future, provided more than 16,500 client education hours in healthy relationship and success development classes, school assemblies, parent education and weekend relationship retreats serving 4,166 youth and emerging adults (ages 15-29) throughout Denver as well as statewide.

The Diamond Standard, our in-depth curriculum, provided 20-25 hours of psycho-social skill development to each of 428 participants throughout Denver and trained 18 curriculum educators for statewide expansion.

24-Hour Helpline

Alternatives received over 1,300 client-related calls on the Helpline.

Pregnancy Tests

Our clients received 1,138 pregnancy tests; 369 tested negative, 733 positive.

Auraria Campus Pregnancy Test Kits

878 pregnancy test kits were distributed to students on campus.

Ultrasound Services

We provided 441 women with 531 ultrasounds.

Direct Client Support

1,349 Gifts of financial and/or material services were provided, including: \$12,583 Help with rent and utilities 332 Pregnancy books 354 Gift layettes (baby shower in a bag) 484 Bottles of prenatal vitamins

Birthdays

We have recorded the births of 411 babies born to clients who gave us written permission to stay connected with them. We will learn of many other babies already born as 2012 progresses and our clients contact us.

Post-Abortion Healing

More than 350 women and men sought our help with emotional pain and loss due to past abortion.

Volunteer Time

Our volunteer counseling, medical and office personnel provided 9,393 hours of service in 2011. Also, 365 days of 24-hour coverage was provided on our Helpline by faithful volunteers.

737 individuals in the Denver metro area served as volunteers. Their time and talents equip Alternatives to serve our clients in every aspect of the ministry.
