- 1. Before you viewed the video from our Men's Program Director, Rob Denler, what was your perception of the services provided at Alternatives? Has that perception changed since watching the video?
- 2. Rob stated in the video, "...it is difficult, if not nearly impossible, to be a good father unless you are first a good man." Many of our male clients come through our doors as fathers-to-be before they have fully developed their character as a man. We have a fatherhood crisis." What are some specific ways that we can start impacting this fatherhood crisis?
- 3. What does it mean for us, as Christians, to be pro-life beyond the pregnancy decision?
- 4. Alternatives offers Counseling After Abortion for men. In every unexpected or unintended pregnancy there are two people involved. Why do you believe Counseling After Abortion is seen largely as a resource for women?
- 5. With many men in the Church having an abortion experience in their past, how can we reach out and offer them a path to find healing and closure?
- 6. We are called to care for the widows and orphans (James 1:27). Today, what tangible ways can we, as a group, care for others and serve God in this way? How can we serve families that are clients of Alternatives?
