The team provides classroom instruction, parent workshops and training for local youth-serving professionals.

Instructor Aide

Assist the Lead Instructor with classroom set-up in a local high school, develop relationships with students and help them stay on task.

Client Services

Through non-judgmental, compassionate care and medically-accurate education, our Client Services team supports women and men faced with a life-altering pregnancy decision or compromised sexual health.

24-Hour Helpline Information Assistance

Listen and assist callers with information about our services after office hours and on weekends. Training provided.

Client Advocate

Equip and support women and men to make informed decisions around unexpected pregnancy. Application and interview process required. Training provided.

Counseling After Abortion Group Facilitator

Provide a safe, trusted place and caring support for women and men struggling with a past pregnancy decision and help them walk the path toward healing. Application and interview process required. Training provided.

Fatherhood Mentor

Support a male client and help him become an involved, committed and responsible father. Mentorship extends from early pregnancy until his child is six months of age. Training provided.

Sonographer

Perform ultrasound scans on pregnant women to determine gestational age, viability and location of the pregnancy. MD, RDMS, NP, RN or DO required.

STD Clinician

Provide risk assessment and consultation along with a testing and treatment plan and education. MD, PA-C, NP or RN required. Training provided.

Ambassadors

Through individual and group connections, our ambassadors help us build a culture of life and advocate for the wellbeing of teens, women and men in our community.

Connect the A Promising Future team to the administration of your local high school to bring The Diamond Standard curriculum to the school.

Campus

Join our Community and Campus Outreach team to spread awareness of services to women and men who are highly vulnerable to the pressure of a pregnancy decision and in need of support.
