Position Summary:

Church ambassadors are an integral part of the Communications & Community Development team. This person serves as a liaison between Alternatives and their church to create and deepen the awareness and understanding of the programs and services of Alternatives.

Time Commitment:

2-4 hours per month

Application Requirements

- Attend a Volunteer Orientation.
- Attend a Foundations Course.
- Apply by the given deadline (provided by the Volunteer Development Manager).
- Be formally interviewed by Supervisor (scheduled by the Supervisor and Volunteer Development Manager.)

Training Requirements

- Attend Virtual Orientation and Foundations
- Optional training includes: Google Classroom Prep Work: 3 hours The Alternatives Approach: 15 hours On the Job Training: 6-8 hours

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Facilitate a meeting with the pastoral staff at your church and the Director of Communications & Community Engagement; promote Courageous Conversations workshop.
- Ongoing representation of Alternatives and consistent communication back to Alternatives
- Advocate for Alternatives at the church looking for ways for the church and Alternatives to partner.
- Look for ways for Alternatives to serve the church through young adult programs, parent education, MOPS or small groups, etc.
- Help coordinate the church's observance of Sanctity of Human Life Sunday and other Alternatives events and fundraisers.

General Requirements:

- Committed to Alternatives' mission statement and the sanctity of human life.
- Signed agreement of Alternatives' Statement of Faith and Principle.
- Attend Alternatives fundraising and appreciation events as needed.

Alternatives Pregnancy Center exists to care for Denver-area women and men in pregnancy-related crisis and offer them a meaningful alternative to abortion. Following the example of Christian love, we seek to meet their emotional, physical and spiritual needs. And we enable and encourage them to choose life every day.

We provide a 24-Hour Helpline, pregnancy tests and options counseling, limited ultrasound services, abortion pill reversal referrals, STD testing and treatment, adoption education, pre- and post-natal medical care referrals, financial and legal referrals, counseling after abortion, positive youth development curriculum and sexual risk avoidance education. All services are confidential and provided free of charge.
